## The Back of Your Ring Doorbell

→ Setup Button The orange button on the back of your Ring Doorbell is the **setup** button. You'll

be instructed to push this button during the in-app setup process.

 ← Charging Port If you're not

wiring your Ring Doorbell, you'll need to charge t periodically by plugging the provided orange cable into the harging port.

# Testing Your Ring Doorbell

## Push the Front Button to Run a Test

After setup, push the front button on your Ring Doorbell indoors near your router to see video from your Ring Doorbell in the Ring app.



Then test your Ring Doorbell

If video quality from your Ring Doorbell is not as good outdoors as it is indoors, you may need to move your router closer to your door, or invest in a Wi-Fi

extender.

## Remove Your Existing Doorbell (optional)

Installation

If you're replacing a wired doorbell, first turn off the power at the breaker

If you notice a diode when you remove your wired doorbell, take note of this, as it means you will need to use the included diode.



## Install the Mounting Bracket

Take everything that came in the box, along with a power drill if you're installing on stucco, brick, or concrete, to the spot where you'll be installing your Ring Doorbell.

On wood or siding, you can skip this step, and screw the bracket directly into your wall.




